



Paediatric and Adolescent Gynaecology Services

Welcome to the Paediatric and Adolescent Gynaecology Clinic in Glasgow Royal Infirmary.

This service is designed for young people who have problems with their female organs. This could be due to heavy or painful periods, differences of sexual development, pelvic pain and other conditions.

You will usually see a gynaecologist at the clinic. Sometimes it is useful for you to have an examination, although not always. If you are worried about this, please talk to your doctor.

We work together as a team; other staff include our plastic surgeon and our nurse. We can offer referral to clinical psychology and clinical genetics if needed. Staff from children's services and fertility services are also part of our team.

Sometimes it is useful for you to have blood tests or ultrasound and other scans arranged. We will always explain these to you.

We train medical students from the University of Glasgow and specialist doctors and General Practitioners in Obstetrics and Gynaecology. Your consent may be requested for the presence of medical students. You are perfectly free to decline to have a student present during your consultation or examination.
